In Important Notice A#7556, P&S# 7126 dated December 21, 2012, the National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC) described the requirements for the CNS ACATS and DTC settling assets project.

This Notice announces the publication of the revised record layouts for ACATS output files that will include a new value in the **Settling Location Reason** field: 'NTRN' = 6-year (PREMed) Non-Transferable.

Below is a table that lists the names of the files that will include this new value, and their Autoroute numbers in both the testing and production environments.
