<b>SUBJECT:</b>	DTC Proposed Rule Change – Amendment to the Reorganizations Service Guide (SR-DTC-2022-007)

On **Tuesday, June 28, 2022**, The Depository Trust Company (“DTC”) submitted a proposed rule change (File No. SR-DTC-2022-007) (“Rule Filing”) to the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Rule Filing would amend the Reorganizations Service Guide to provide Participants with the option to submit certain instructions via APIs and ISO 20022 real-time messaging for eligible ATOP, ASOP and APUTS voluntary reorganizations offers.
